What does this mean?

- Copies of your Annual Budget and monthly P&A reports will be sent to your designated Lion (*form has been updated and will be sent to each club secretary*).
- You must have open lines of communications with your Lions Club; to include all projects or events you are hosting. This is very important as your club is part of their club insurance. Please provide the names of all of your club members to your Lions Club (if you have not already done so).

If your club chooses to dissolve, you will need to follow the procedures for "Dissolved Lioness Club". Please contact me if this is the option you have chosen for your club.

Lions International continues to encourage current Lioness Clubs to join the Lions family by extending the Join together program to 2021. If you would like to learn more or would like assistance with a transition to become Lioness/Lions, please email or phone me. I would be happy to assist your club however I may.
